Ruling on Ordinances

**CAN'T BE PUBLISHED IN VILLAGE
WITHOUT OPPOSING PAPERS.**

Zanesville, June 18.—Village ordinances cannot be published in village papers alone, or in them at all if the papers are independent, according to the decision of the court of appeals reached here today. Vermillion and 60 others enjoined the paving of Main street in New Concord, claiming the ordinance was illegal. The judges held that ordinances for improvement must be published in papers of opposite politics and that they can be placed in papers not published in the village but having a general circulation therein. The decision will affect every village or small town in the state not having two papers of opposite politics.
